Define Data Access for Individual Users and Groups

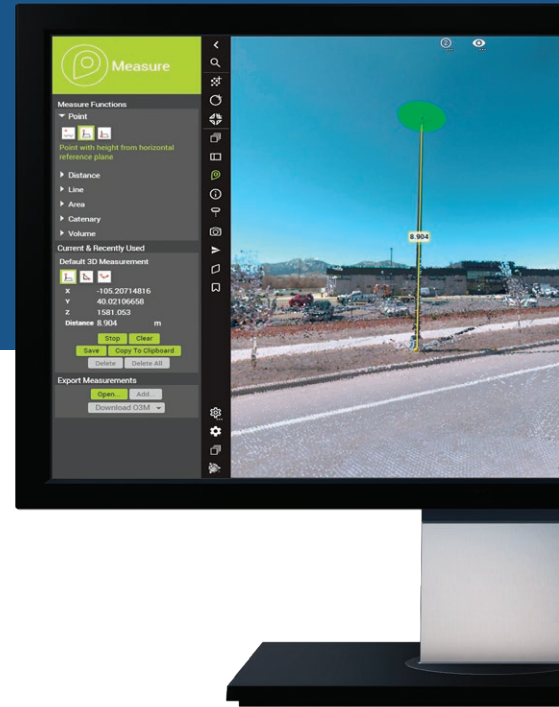
Trimble® MX Publisher enables publication administrators to set credentials for individual users and user groups, controlling their access level to the published data.

Perform Simple but Powerful Measurements

Measure points, lines, area, catenaries, distances or volumes utilising point cloud data and imagery. Then, save measurement results locally on your PC or in common GIS and CAD environments using the available plugins.

Integrate with GIS and CAD Environments or With Your Own App

Trimble MX Publisher plugins allow access of your mobile mapping data through common GIS and CAD environments such as ArcMap, ArcGIS Pro, QGIS, AutoCAD. An example could be that map users can save measurement results directly into a GIS layer or geodatabase. An SDK enables you to integrate the viewer into your own application, website, GIS or CAD system.

SYSTEM REQUIREMENTS:

GENERAL REQUIREMENTS:

Operating System Microsoft® Windows® 7.8 or 10 Processor 64bit, 2.8 GHz quad-core or higher RAM 16 to 32 GB Graphic Card No requirements

SERVER DISKS & DISK-SPACE:

A Trimble MX Server installation is about 500MB, preferably installed on a dedicated partition. Reserve 10 to 50 GB free disk-space.

BROWSER:

An up to date Chrome, Firefox or Safari browser.

NETWORK:

Internet/Intranet Connection:

For data hosting the server upload and client download speed relative to the average size of the data to be served at the same time needs to be taken into account:

- Minimum server upload speed of 200 Mbps
- Minimum client download speed of 20 Mbps

Port:

Trimble MX Publisher (server) - publishing client communication requires a single port to operate. The default configuration is set to port 1111, it can be reconfigured as needed. Port 80 and 443 are also required to communicate over HTTP and HTTPS respectively. In addition, a Proxy server usage is supported.

Web server:

Trimble MX Publisher includes a web server supporting HTTP/HTTPS and WS/WSS communication.

Client access to publication: If you would like to make your Trimble MX publications available via the Internet, public access to the Trimble MX Server is required. Publications can also be configured for intranet systems.

Web sockets:

Trimble MX Publisher Viewer and Plugins use the WebSockets communication protocol. Some systems will bypass this when using HTTPS.
